Your vendor space:

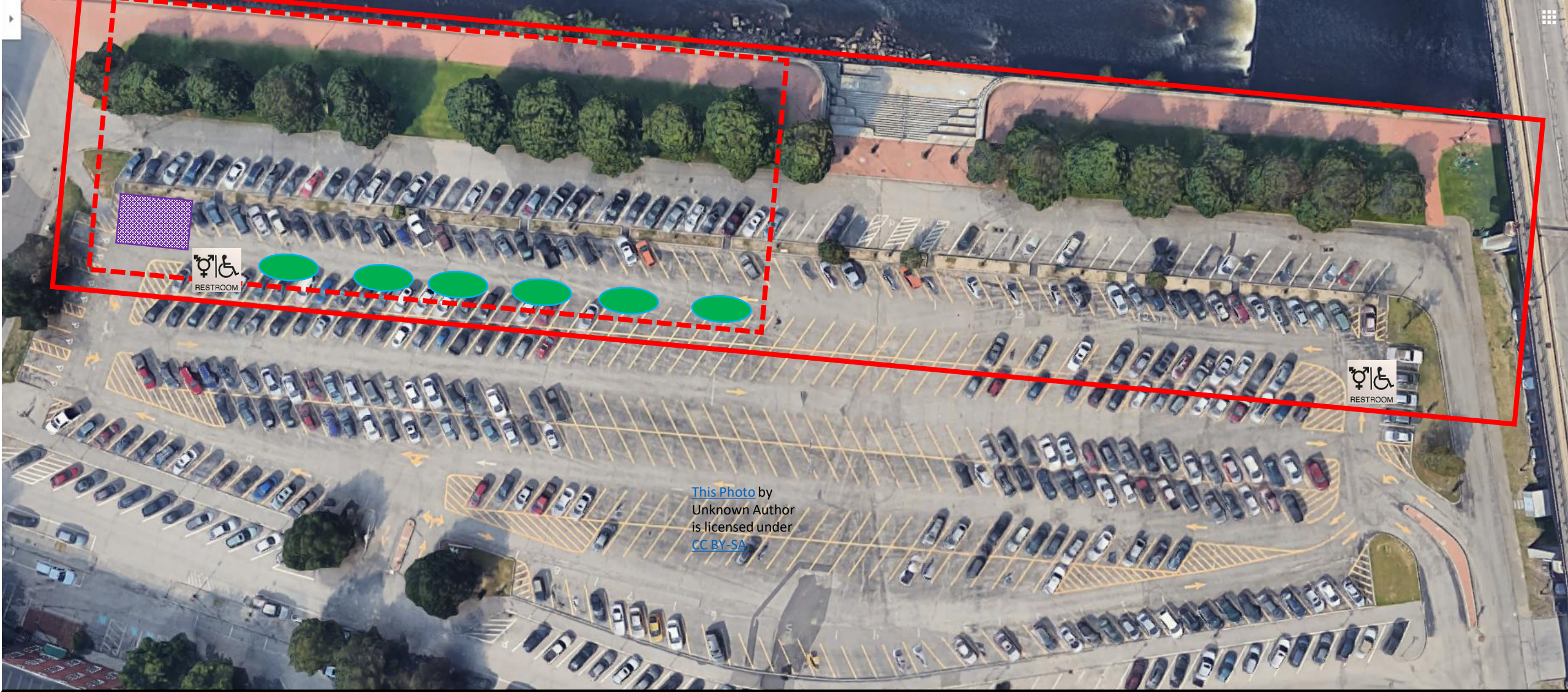
- Queen City Pride will provide a 6' table and 2 chairs
- Your overall "space" is about 12' x 12'
- You can bring your own pop-up tent. A 10' tent will fit in your space
- We are spacing vendors approximately 12'-14' apart for social distancing. So yes, there is some spill over area outside of the 12' box we assign.
- A festival map is provided on our website

Information about setting up/FAQs




- Point of contact for the day is Steven Kidder, 603.568.6606.
- Setup time is between 10 and 12. Festival is from 12-6. You can stay as little or long as you want.
- When you arrive, you can park in the Arms Park lot, outside of festival area. See overall aerial map below.
- Check-in with Steven. He will show you to your spot.
- You will be provided two (2) vendor passes at check-in. This is simply to identify you as a vendor to attendees and a thank you from QCP. If you have multiple volunteers, they will not require a Vendor Pass or ticket to enter. They can simply arrive and come to your table.
- Food and drinks will be available during the day. Alcoholic beverages should be consumed in the designated drinking area
- You are responsible for cleaning up any trash or waste product before you leave. Trash and recycling bins will be provided throughout the festival.
- You are responsible for complying with all laws regarding any sales or transactions you perform during the event.
- We have facemasks and sanitizer for each table, if requested.
